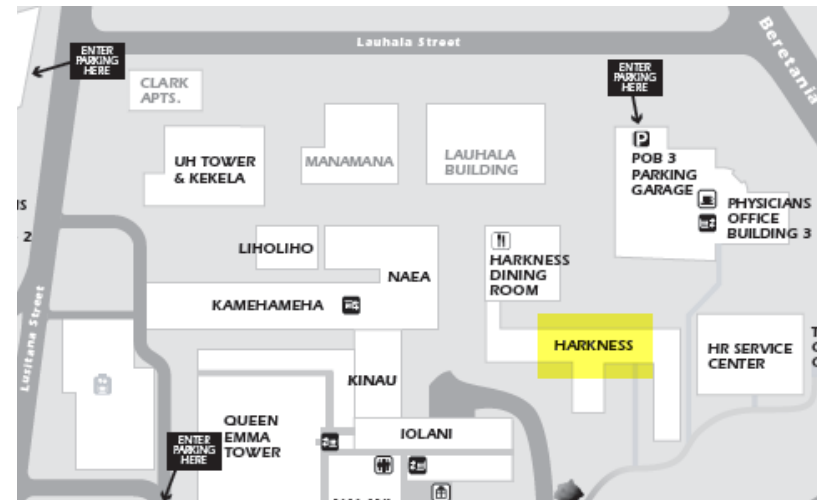

Mike is the Vice President, Government Relations & Community Affairs for Hawai'i Pacific Health (HPH) where he has been employed the last 17 years.

Hawai'i Pacific Health is the non-profit health care system comprised of Kapi'olani Medical Center for Women & Children, Pali Momi Medical Center, Straub Medical Center and Wilcox Medical Center on Kaua'i.

Mike began his professional career in Hawai'i as an urban planner with architectural firm Media Five, Ltd. He later went on to work as a real estate analyst with John Child & Company and made his first move into the non-profit sector while working at the University of Hawai'i Foundation

Dr. Eugene Tian is the Chief Economist at the Hawaii State Department of Business, Economic Development & Tourism (DBEDT). His office conducts research on economic issues such as tourism, emerging industries, diversification, quality of life, technology, energy, and taxation. His team also produces the official statewide short-range economic forecast on a quarterly basis and the long-range population and economic forecast every 5 years.

His program is also responsible for compiling and publishing the State of Hawaii Data Book, the monthly economic and energy indicators, the daily passengers count to Hawaii.

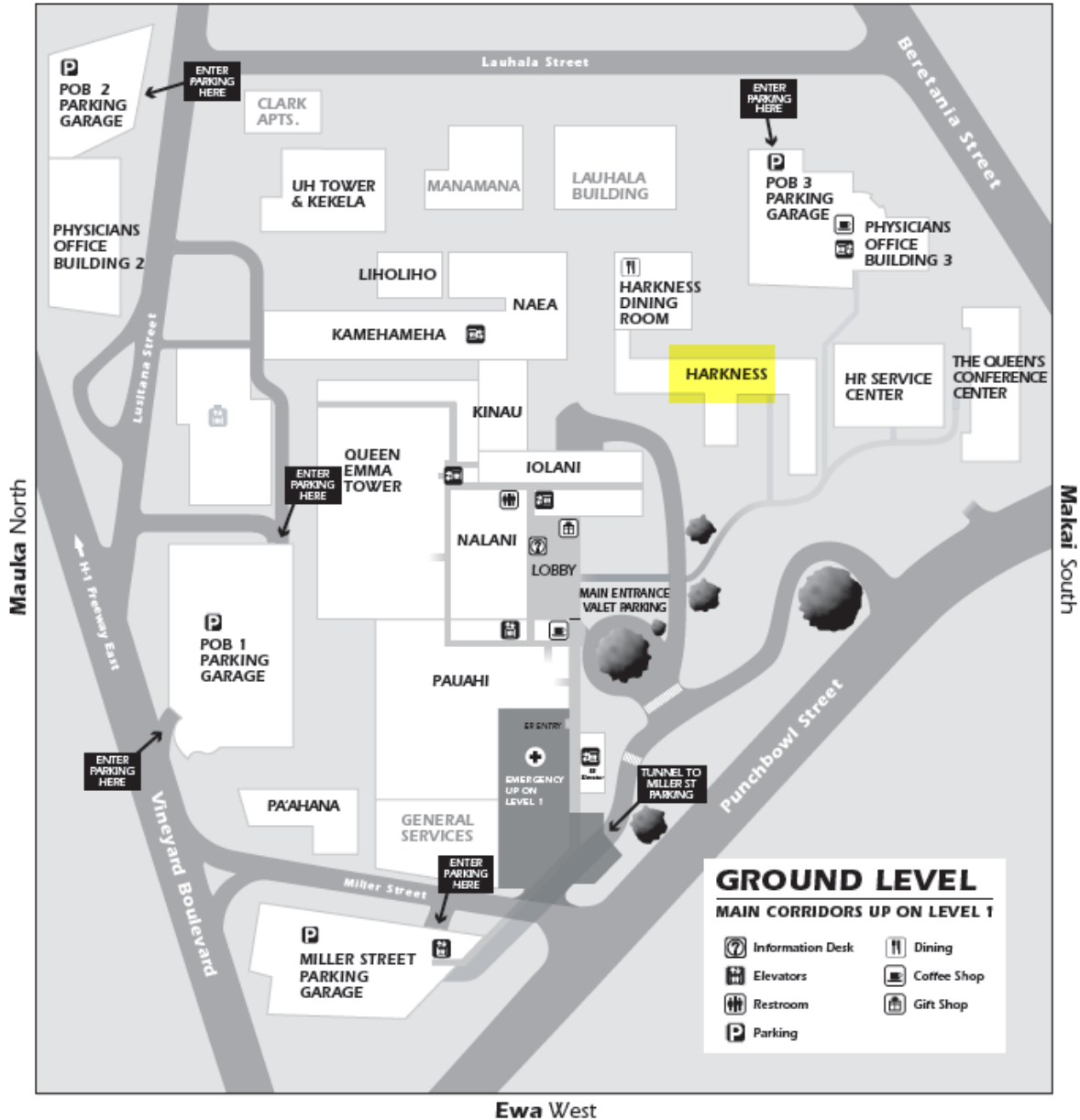
The Hawaii State Data Center program is also a part of his office. Data center staff work on coordinating, organizing, maintaining, and analyzing Hawaii census data.
